Go to File > New > Document. Increase the Number of Pages to 32 and keep Facing Pages selected. Under Page Size choose your pre-saved custom size, Children's Book Landscape. Set the Margins to 20 mm and add a Bleed of 5 mm on all sides except the Inside edge (where the page will be sucked into the spine).
